Code of Conduct applies to all Coaches, Players and Spectators

1. Beaufort County Parks and Recreation has established the following Code of Conduct for all players, spectators, coaches, managers, and officials to follow.
2. No player, manager, coach, spectator, or official under the influence of alcohol or drugs shall be allowed in the facility. **NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE PARKING LOT.** In addition, the facility supervisor **WILL** notify the police to respond to the facility in case such is notified.
3. Any team allowing the consumption of alcohol or drugs in/on the facility and adjacent grounds by their players shall forfeit the game and will be removed from the league for the remainder of the season and **ABSOLUTELY NO REFUND ON ANY FEES THAT HAVE BEEN PAID BY THE TEAM OR PLAYERS.**
4. There shall be **NO TOBACCO** at the facilities by anyone. Violators will be asked to leave or be removed from the facility.
5. Anyone ordered to leave by an official shall obey and immediately leave the facility (parking lot included). Failure to comply will result in being given a minimum three (3) game suspension.
6. Players suspended for flagrant violation of rules cannot play again until meeting with and being reinstated by the Deputy Director or Director. Any appeals will need to go to the Deputy Director.
7. Switching jerseys during the game is not allowed and will result in **ALL** players switching jerseys removed from the game and suspended for the next game.
8. Any players or coach ejected from a game will automatically be suspended for the next game, regular season or post season game. Anyone suspended twice in one season will be suspended from the remainder of the season. Any head coach or assistant coach ejected, removed or suspended from the regular season will not be allowed to coach or assist any team in post season or All-Star games. After the season Parks and Recreation will then review any further coaching in our programs.

Additional disciplinary action for players, coaches, managers, and fans will be as follows:

1. All players/coaches are required to shake hands with the opposing team after each game.	Child - Warning Coach – 1 game suspension	Child - 1 game suspension Coach – 3 game suspension
2. No coach shall touch a child in an aggressive manner.	1 game suspension	Season suspension – After season re-instatement pending.
3. Abusive or offensive words or language said out loud in any type of unsportsmanlike conduct but not directed at anyone.	Current game plus 1 additional game suspension.	Current season suspension.*
4. Abusive/offensive words or language directed at officials, staff, players or spectators in any type of unsportsmanlike conduct.	Current game plus 3 additional game suspension.	Current season suspension.*
5. Threat of physical abuse directed at officials, staff players or spectators.	Suspension for current season plus 1 year probation.	During probationary period suspension for remainder of probation period plus 2 years probation.
6. Physical fighting with teammates, spectators, officials, staff.	Suspension for current plus 1 year probation.	Permanent suspension from all sports.
7. Defacing, damaging, or destroying property or equipment.	1 game suspension up to permanent suspension (depending on repair and cost)	Current season suspension up to permanent.
8. Any coach under the influence of drugs or alcohol during games or practices.	Permanent suspension from all sports.	
9. Any team under the influence of drugs or alcohol during games or practices.	Suspension for current season plus 1 year probation.	Permanent suspension of the team and individuals committing the offense.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If suspension occurs at the last game of regular season, suspension will carry over into any post season tournament. If suspension occurs during post season tournament, suspension will carry over into the next Parks and Recreation sport season that the player/coach participates in. (Not necessarily the same sport in which the suspension occurred) • NOTE: If any suspension occurs from any spectator, coach, or child during the season they will be required to watch the code of ethics video at the Parks and Recreation office before returning.
